- Name of the Institution -** Union Graduate College
- Title and Description -** MS: Electrical, Mechanical, Computer Science, and Engineering and Management
- Type of Course-** Flexible Full or Part-time (full-time required for F1 and J1 students)
- Length of the Course -** Flexible depending on student's academic background and experience. Full time students generally complete the programs in 9 - 15 months. Part time students may take 20 or more months. The College is on the Trimester system and offers 1 summer session.
- Date the course commences -** Students may enroll at the beginning of any of the 5 sessions. Admissions decisions are made on a rolling basis. Fall term (September)/Winter term (January)/Spring term (April) Summer 1 term (June) / Summer 2 term (July)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- First Degree Requirements -** Admission to one of the engineering programs is based on post-secondary academic achievement and intellectual promise, career goals, potential contribution to the college community, and personal recommendations. Requirements: Bachelor Degree (four year)
- TOEFL Score -** Minimum of 550 (213 computer based) Non-U.S. applicants who have not studied for at least two years in an English-speaking program must also submit an official score from the Test of English as a Foreign Language. A score of 600 (250 computer based) is preferred.

- International transcript professional evaluation
- Three letters of recommendation
- Resume
- TOEFL or IELTS Language Fluency - English

Admission can be Deferred – one year
